3. Clearly define the objectives of the working model and its introduction.
4. Take necessary precautions especially dealing with electricity or sharp objects.
5. The base (either cardboard or thermocole) of the model should be covered with a chart paper or use plyboard (in case of heavy Model)
6. Labelling should be done and it must be clearly visible. (Pla-card/ charts can be used)
7. For both working and Non- working models, prepare a written report on chart regarding concepts and principles associated with the topic. Use reasonably big letters to write on chart paper.
8. The explanation of the model should be informative, Knowledgeable, effective and in english only.
9. You can assemble the different components of the model in the school if it is bigger in size.
